An award-winning software craftsmanship coach with a proven track record of success in transforming organisations' software applications. Coaches and trains teams in Extreme Programming to continuously improve their software development lifecycle and produce high-quality software. Looking for opportunities to help teams improve their software craftsmanship skills as a Technical Software Coach.

Achievements

Technical Skills Transformation

- Led an organisation transformation of ~1,000 developers across London, Brazil, and Mexico through training dojos on Extreme Programming practices. This led to improved communication, negotiating requirements, continuous integration and faster development, which meant that features matched users' expectations.
- Created and delivered a course on basic data analysis using Jupyter Notebooks, which enabled both technical and non-technical participants to make more data-driven decisions for building their applications. This reduced to five minutes, the recreation of reports with updated data that had previously taken two hours.
- Organised outward mindset classes and a guild for an organisation of over 260 people. This increased the teams' ability to achieve their objectives and key results (OKRs).
- Received the "Peer-to-Peer Recognition - Growth Minded" award for transforming the organisation.

Modernising a business partner application on NodeJS

- Created a NodeJS application that automated opportunity, incentive, and deal registration creation for 10k business partners and their 200k users handling 10 billion USD\$.
- The transformation led to users instantly recording the opportunities and products they were selling. In comparison, the old process could take them days as they waited for each step to complete.
- Led, mentored, and coached a tribe of 18 developers, to enable them to improve their technical skills, get promoted and for 3 of them to take on squad lead roles.
- Earned an Outstanding Technical Achievement Award for modernising the user experience, simplifying the user journey, and cutting the development cost by almost 90%.

DevOps Transformation

- Transformed the deployment process for an on-premises instance which took seventy-two hours to be able to run within two hours.
- Continuously sought areas that were not automated. This freed up two people in operations during deployment weekends and reduced the time of deployments, thereby giving the team a better quality of life.
- Awarded the Outstanding Technical Achievement Award for being the first team to introduce Urban Code Deployment and use it to deploy to production.

Modernised a legacy partner relationship management application using NodeJS, REST APIs and AngularJS which reduced deal registration time from 2 days to 2 minutes. Tribe-lead for a group of 18 developers simplifying opportunity management, incentives and deal registration.

Led a squad of developers to automate the deployment of SugarCRM along with several microservices which removed the need for developers to be online for hours for deployments. Also, developed collaboration features in PHP integrating IBM Connections into SugarCRM which ensured that everyone on the deal knew the latest details of its progress.
